Develop a new attitude toward dating

Purity

Respect the deep significance of physical intimacy.

Set your standard too high.

Girls, dress modestly with propriety to honor your brothers.

Start with a Clean Slate

Repent of sinful attitudes and behavior in your present and past dating relationships.

Break any soul ties.

Break off an ungodly relationship and make sure the focus is on Jesus if it is a godly relationship.

Make your parents (or spiritual mentors) your teammates

Establish protective boundaries.

Check who is whispering in your ear.

Understand the difference between friendship and intimacy.

Be inclusive, not exclusive.

Seek opportunities to serve, not to be entertained.

Behave as ladies and gentlemen.

Build one another up in the Lord.

Avoid mentoring the opposite sex, point to older men/women.
