

Dual Enrollment in Florida!



The State of Florida provides a way for high school students to earn college credits while they are still in high school. The program is called dual enrollment and is available to homeschooled students who are registered with the county or under an umbrella school.

Dual enrollment courses are free, but homeschoolers must pay for their own books (public schools provide books for public high school students). To be eligible for dual enrollment, a homeschooled student must have a 3.0 or above grade point average for college credit classes or a 2.0 or above grade point to enroll in vocational classes. They must pass the college placement test offered by the college or university they are enrolling in.

Dual enrollment courses qualify for both high school and college credit. For example, Julianna took a 4 credit Spanish I class at SCC which gave her 1 high school credit toward high school graduation and 4 college credits toward college graduation.
